- The logo **must** reflect the theme of the conference.
- While indicating the **relevance to GIS domain**, the logo can also reflect the **local identity**.
- It must **not** resemble other conference logos, anywhere in the world.
- It should not include any copyrighted materials.
- The design should be submitted in a vector graphic format (e.g.: SVG) with source file and a high resolution sample in PNG.
